Proposed youth exchange is aimed at intercultural learning, fight against prejudice and xenophobia, non-formal learning through common art process and street art workshops. Art is the tool of personal development, development of creativity, mutual understanding and self-expression of young people.

Special emphasis and importance is placed on the co-operation and creating of network between participants from Roma treaty Europe and new or future Europe. The project is a way to promote the role of European Union and citizenship.

Educational workshops for participants, aimed at project management, fundraising, preparation of international youth exchanges, creation of international network of youth organisations in European Union, a methodology of intercultural learning through art experience, are internal part of this exchange.

Including cooperation with various experts in the field of using art for intercultural learning and understanding the project creates a bridge between non-formal and formal education in accordance with the White Book of European Union.

The project is part of an event organised in the region by a pilot group (adeppa-together-famille rurale ) who has as aim to promote the 50th anniversary of the Roma Treaty under the motto "we don't want to hear about Europe we want to express ourselves"(see attachment)
